

Helmet Policy

Effective July 3rd, 2008 **Revised June 2019**All revisions are noted with **BOLD** text.

All minor hockey team officials, volunteers, NCCP instructors and third party on ice instructors working with Associations, Teams or Clubs, MUST wear a CSA approved hockey helmet secured and chinstraps properly fastened, during all sanctioned on-ice activities. For those participants wearing a facial protector, the straps of the facial protector, when designed to allow such straps, shall also be securely fastened to the hockey helmet. Trainers or any other team officials who enter the ice surface for the purpose of attending an injured player are exempt from this rule.

It's the member's responsibility to monitor and enforce the helmet policy.

Any person found to be in violation of this rule will receive a **written** warning for a first offence, a two-week suspension for a second offence, and a one-year suspension for a third offence.
